

THINGS TO REMEMBER ON PACKING DAY

1. Unsafe items which cannot be shipped by the moving company are
 - Perishables
 - Aerosols
 - House Plants (can be moved at the owners risk)
 - Flammables
 - Liquids
2. High value items that cannot be shipped by the moving company are:
 - Cash
 - Coin Collections
 - Jewelry
 - Stocks and Bonds
3. Plan to be at home and make yourself available to the movers the entire day of packing. Packing times vary depending on the amount of packing you may have as well as the time scheduled by the carrier to perform the services.
4. For the comfort of the children, it is often helpful to have them stay with friends or relatives during the moving process.
5. Have your refrigerator emptied and defrosted by loading day.
6. If packers are to pack high value items, such as silver, works of art, furs, etc., ask them to call you to view the packing of those particular items.
7. Items to be carried to your car and items needed that night or the next morning should be segregated so that the packers do not pack them in error.
